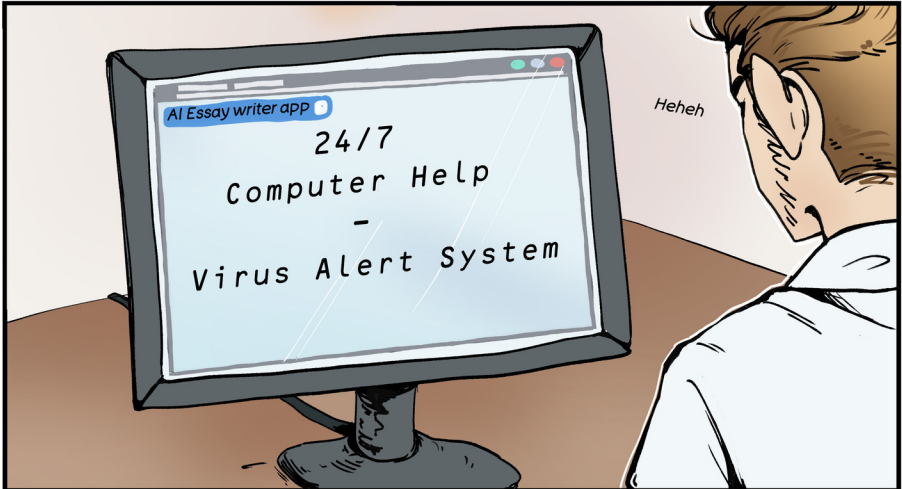
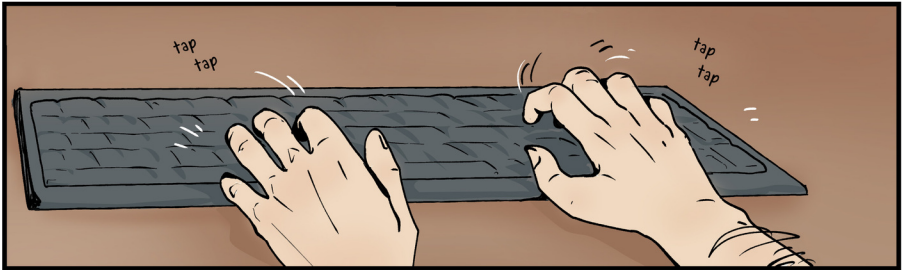
Welcome to Behind the Screen—a groundbreaking comic book series by young people, for young people, created in Scotland!
